" the reason I was born and came into the world is <u>to testify to the truth</u> . Everyone or the side of <u>truth</u> listens to me." ³⁸ " <u>What is truth</u> ?" retorted Pilate John 18:37-38 NIV
> Truth is, constant, and true for everyone, everywhere, the time.

Two Truths About Truth
1. Just because you something doesn't make it true.
"The human heart is the most deceitful of all things, and desperately wicked. Who really knows how bad it is?" Jeremiah 17:9 NLT
The Danger With "Your Truth"
 There are no absolute truths that apply to all people. Morality becomes subjective because right and wrong are relative. My perception determines what's true. I am the source of truth. If it's true to me, you can't question "my truth."
Preach the <u>word of God</u> Patiently correct, rebuke, and encourage your people with <u>good teaching</u> . ³ For a time is coming when people will no longer listen to sound and wholesome teaching. <u>They will follow their own desires</u> and will look for teachers who will tell them whatever their itching ears want to hear. ⁴ They will reject the truth and chase <u>after myths</u> . 2 Timothy 4:2-4 NLT
2. Truth isn't just something we believe; truth is we follow.
Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." John 14:6 NIV
> If Jesus' truth is from what you believe, then to "your truth" and live according to "the truth."
"What is truth?" retorted Pilate. With this he went out again to the Jews gathered there and said, "I find no basis for a charge against [Jesus]. ³⁹ But it is your custom for me to release to you one prisoner at the time of the Passover.
